



## Location Filming Fees

Filming at The Maritime Aquarium for commercial purposes is prohibited without prior approval.

The following fees will apply to approved projects:

- 7 a.m. – 6 p.m. \$500 per hour
- Outside work day \$600 per hour
- Behind the scenes \$300 - \$400 per hour

There is a two-hour minimum. A 25% premium will be charged on weekends.

Also:

- Non-commercial filming projects may request an exemption from fee payment. These will be considered on a case-by-case basis.
- Staff will be provided during the workday (7 a.m. – 6 p.m.) to liaise between the Aquarium, its visitors, and the film crew. Additional staff charges may apply outside the regular workday.
- Filming cannot conflict with previously scheduled events at the Aquarium.
- Visitors can periodically be stopped, but they must not be blocked from the normal visitor experience.
- Filming cannot harm or harass the Aquarium's live animal collection.
- Additional rooms can be rented for a standard fee for makeup, wardrobe, etc...
- Outside food or caterers are not allowed; film crews must use the Aquarium's food service operator. Buffet service can be provided for an additional fee both during and outside of the Aquarium's normal operating hours.
- Proof of insurance that meets the Aquarium's specifications is required.
